**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – MARCH 13, 2024
STRATEGIC PLAN FOR 2024-2028**

The **Ventura County Area Agency on Aging (VCAAA)** will hold a public hearing on **MARCH 13, 2024 at 9:30 a.m.** to receive public comments on the Strategic Plan for 2024-2028, specifically services proposed to be provided in FY 2024-2025 (July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025). The strategies and services have been developed to address some of the more critical needs of Ventura County residents aged 60 and older, people with disabilities, and caregivers. The Strategic Plan will be available on the Area Agency on Aging's website, <http://vcaaa.org> on February 12, 2024. The provision of all programs and services is contingent upon the availability of federal and state funds; and those amounts are unknown at this time. Thus, proposed activities are subject to change. Spanish interpretation is available upon request at the hearing. The VCAAA and its Advisory Council shall review and consider input received at the public hearing, and may make changes accordingly in the final document.
